







Eagle Creek has the capacity for 32 classrooms, 30 classrooms within the building and two portable classrooms. We have 25 general education classrooms including four districtwide dual-language classrooms. Eagle Creek also shares its facilities with the APPLE preschool program. The science classroom, library, music classroom, two computer labs and gymnasium (cafeteria) are available for student use throughout the day and complement core student instruction. School Improvement Plan

This year Eagle Creek staff will work as a team to focus on two parts of the APS Strategic Plan:

Providing a Safe and Positive Learning Environment- we have developed common lessons around how "teammates" behave and are working as a school to show teammate behaviors, which include a focus on perseverance, attendance, sportsmanship, working together, and following the "Big 5". A team of teachers will collaborate to create a pyramid of behavioral interventions and staff will continue professional development around Adverse Childhood Experiences.

Student Learning and Achievement- school staff will engage in professional learning and implement the new ELA curriculum with students as well as use the new iReady assessment system to guide instruction and intervention for all students.

Our efforts in these areas will help us reach the goal of increasing student achievement in the area of English Language Arts and decreasing chronic absenteeism and student discipline referrals.
