



### Student Assessment Result Comparisons


3RD GRADE STATE ASSESSMENTS

### Facility Use

Eagle Creek Elementary has the capacity for 32 classrooms, 30 classrooms within the building and two portable classrooms. In 2014-15, we had 25 general education classrooms including four districtwide dual-language classrooms. Other programs included a district self-contained special education program for students in grades K-5, a special education resource classroom, remedial math and reading programs and a highly capable program for qualified students. Eagle Creek also shares its facilities with the APPLE preschool program. The science classroom, library, music classroom, two computer labs and gymnasium (cafeteria) are available for student use throughout the day and complement core student instruction at Eagle Creek.

### School Improvement Plan

The Eagle Creek School Improvement Plan is a driving and organizing force for our students' achievement. This year, we have chosen to provide professional development for staff and students in four key areas:

- Attendance
- Intervention
- High-Performing PLC Teams
- Perseverance

Thus far, our work around attendance has been extensive, and we continue to maintain a strong focus on regular attendance as our primary form of academic intervention. We have set 95 percent daily attendance as our school goal, and have regular communication with students around the "Strive for Five"

attendance emphasis.

This year we are learning strategies to intervene for two historically under-performing groups of students: English Language Learners (ELL) and students in poverty. A team of four teachers is providing leadership for the building in ELL instructional strategies. In addition, teams of teachers and para educators are participating in two book studies (Teaching with Poverty in Mind; Engaging Students with Poverty in Mind). We are also participating in district-wide professional development regarding Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACES). Each of these trainings helps us teach better and help our English Language Learners and students in poverty achieve at higher levels.
